YOUR VILLAGE HALL NEEDS YOUR HELP!

Arbuthnot Hall was given to the (civil) Parish of Wonersh and the neighbourhood to provide a village hall for use of the inhabitants. Shamley Green is very lucky to have this community asset, which has served as a hub for village life since 1905. The Hall charges for use and has benefitted for many years from a generous donation from the Arbuthnot Hall 200 Club, which gives half of its proceeds to the Hall with the rest given out in prizes, but this is not enough to keep our Hall running.



The Hall is in urgent need of improvements, as identified in a recent independent survey of the building. The Hall committee expects to present recommendations for the future development of the Hall to the village in the Autumn. Irrespective of the future development plans, for which we will be seeking grants and other funding, we now need to raise extra revenue for the increasing costs of running the Hall.

'Friends of Arbuthnot Hall' Scheme

In order to increase revenue and raise the Hall's profile, the Trustees of Arbuthnot Hall are launching an initiative to secure this community asset for the future and we hope that we can count on your support. Our proposal is to set up a '**Friends of Arbuthnot Hall**' scheme to which all can donate. All proceeds of this scheme will accrue to the Hall and, as the Hall is a charity, it can currently claim Gift Aid of an extra 25%.

As a **Friend of Arbuthnot Hall** you will be making a valuable contribution. To join we suggest an annual minimum donation of **£30** per year to be paid by standing order. Details of how to donate and apply are on the reverse of this leaflet.
